

Magic Squares



A magic square is square grid with special arrangements of numbers in them

Today's maths activity involves placing the first 9 counting numbers into a 3 x 3 grid so that each row, column, and diagonal add up to the same total.

What you need:

- Paper Pencils
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS


- Draw and cut out the numbers from 1 to 9 on 9 cards
 - Draw a 3 x 3 square grid
- Place the numbered cards into the grid so that the sum of each row, column and diagonal is equal to the same target number
 - Can you figure out a suitable target number? 4.

Hints(only use if you're struggling!)

The sum of each row, column and diagonal should add up to a target number of 15

Place the number 5 into the middle box

Put the even numbers into the corners



Write a hope you have for the future in the centre and then get creative designing your balloon. Print out the Balloon Template and write your name and your class on the back.

Try not to cover your lovely writing with your design. Return your balloon to school on the same day you are returning your School Books-
